

Using funds from two New Jersey Sustainable Schools grants as well as \$1000 from Walmart, students and staff at Mount Arlington schools are using pedal-a-watt generators and bicycles to charge batteries. The batteries in turn are used to power the sound system in the PE classes. In the future mini-greenhouses will be installed and seedlings will be grown and monitored. The PowerUp grant is a wellness initiative to promote healthy lifestyle choices.

The PowerSave program has students conducting an energy audit of each room and office. After the audit students have developed energy saving steps for each room.
